FixMyStreet is a great tool for teaching children that they can take control of, and responsibility for, the problems in their own local neighbourhood.

You may like to use the site as supporting material if you are doing work around such key areas as mapping your local area or improving your community.

We have included some text below, if you would like to send an email or letter to parents; please feel free to adapt this to your needs.

Dear Parents,

We'd like to draw your attention to a useful website that you and your family might like to use.

www.FixMyStreet.com allows you to report common street problems - things like potholes, broken streetlights, dog fouling or dangerous pavements - directly to the local council.

You don't need to know who's responsible for fixing it: so long as you can mark the problem on a map, FixMyStreet will send your report to the right place.

We'd love it if everyone got involved with reporting issues around [*name of school/hall etc*] and helped to improve our community. By taking part, we hope that children will learn that they can have an effect on their own local environment.

Children are welcome to use the site, although they may need adult supervision, and an email address is required.
